

KEHILLAH HOUSING

Portland, Oregon

Design for a 15 unit apartment for mentally disabled young adults. Combining living units and social support facilities, the building contains a living/community/dining room with community kitchen, fireplace, and support staff offices. Outdoor areas include a community patio, community garden, and parking area. Apartment units are1 bedroom/1 bath with full kitchen and are 540 net square feet. Using rainscreen wall design, it achieved a Gold Earth Advantage Certification. The building was also designed for future roof mounted solar arrays. Funding is from HUD, Oregon Housing, and Portland Housing Bureau. Construction completed November 2013.
