FACADE RENOVATION

Los Angeles, California

To focus more attention to the courtyard of this 3,500 square foot "U" shaped building the facade was broken into two masses, separated by a decorative entry gate into the courtyard. False facades were added above the existing parapets to create more vertical composition. The round motif was repeated in circular cut-outs in the new walls and with curved pipe frames behind the walls to give the facade depth. Lighting back-lit the pipe frames and openings. Work included design, cost estimating, plans and specifications and construction observation. Constructed in 1988.
