CHINA-ON-RYE

Restaurant Los Angeles, California

A 1,000 square foot tenant improvement including new dining area and a new kitchen. Chinese motifs were interpreted in a modern vernacular as a background for serving kosher Chinese and kosher delicatessen food. A decorative wall in front separates the eating area from the service area but still provides visual access to the delicatessen case. The wall also provides a place for Chinese art and pottery. Existing ceiling joists were retained and the suspended ceiling placed above them. Work included architectural and furnishing design, cost estimating, preparation of plans and specifications and construction management. Constructed in 1989.
